High Density Polyethylene (HDPE)



The federal drumMUSTER program provides Australian agricultural chemical users with a recycling pathway for eligible empty containers. Once the consumer has used the product, drums are triple rinsed to remove any chemical residue. They are then returned to collection sites around Australia.



Drums can be self delivered to our yard in Welshpool for small quantities, we can collect for large quantities or we process onsite for regional and large metropolitan sites with our mobile shredder.



In 2021 drumMUSTER nationally had collected over 37.5 million drums since it's inception back in 1999. CLAW has proudly supported this venture since the beginning and has collected nearly 5.5 million drums to date and still going .

Drums are processed by shredding to reduce the size, then stored in bulka bags for transport.

Product is shipped for further reprocessing interstate to be made into new products.
